I, _____, the undersigned have read and understand, and freely and voluntarily enter into this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement with **Gingerbread Acres and any and all employees and shareholders**, understanding that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is a waiver of any and all liability(ies).

2. I understand the potential dangers that I could incur in mounting, riding, walking, boarding, feeding, grooming horses; including, but not limited to, any interactions with horses. Understanding those risks I hereby release, acquit, and forever discharge **Gingerbread Acres** its officers, directors, shareholders, employees and anyone else directly or indirectly connected with that Company from any liability whatsoever, including all manner of suits, actions, demands, and liabilities which may arise from this activity, in the event of injury or damage of any nature (or perhaps even death) to me or anyone else caused by or incidental to my electing to interact with, mount or ride a horse owned or operated by **Gingerbread Acres**

3. I understand, recognize and warrant that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement is being voluntarily and intentionally signed and agreed to, and that in signing this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement I know and understand that this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement further limits the liability of equine professionals to include **any activity, whatsoever, involving or not involving an equine**, including death, personal injury and/or damage to property, that occurs on the grounds of **Gingerbread Acres**.

4. I voluntarily agree and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless this (these) equine professional(s) from any liability whatsoever, including, but not limited to, any incident caused by or related to said equine professional's (s') negligence, relating to injuries known, unknown, or otherwise not herein disclosed; including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage from: mounting; riding; dismounting; walking; grooming; feeding; use of horse barn, paddock, trails or horse ring, in any capacity; falling off horse whether horse is bucking, flipping, spooked; or my failure to understand any equine professional's (s') directions relating to my riding or otherwise use and control, or lack thereof, of my horse or the horse I have been assigned to.

5. I understand, recognize and warrant to Release and Hold Harmless **Gingerbread Acres, and any and all employees and shareholders** from *any liability whatsoever* including, but not limited to, *any and all injury* that occurs while on the grounds of **Gingerbread Acres.**

6. I understand, recognize and warrant, that anyone who accompanies me onto the grounds of **Gingerbread Acres.**, is my responsibility to supervise. I understand, recognize and warrant that I this Release and Hold Harmless Agreement releases **Gingerbread Acres** from liability in any form regarding anyone who may accompany me onto the grounds of **Gingerbread Acres** . I voluntarily agree and warrant to assume liability for anyone who accompanies me onto the grounds of **Gingerbread Acres**.

7. I understand that *Florida law, statute 773.01 - 773.05 states:*

An equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or any other person shall not be liable for an injury to or the death of a participant resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities and, except as provided in s. 773.03, no participant nor any participant's representative shall have any claim against or recover from any equine activity sponsor, equine professional, or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of _____ the participant resulting from any of the inherent risks of equine activities.

"Inherent risks of equine activities" means those dangers or conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including, but not limited to:

(a) The propensity of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them.

(b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals.

(c) Certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions.

(d) Collisions with other equines or objects.

(e) The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within his or her ability.

"Participant" means any person, whether amateur or professional, who engages in or any equine that participates in an equine activity, whether or not a fee is paid to participate in the equine activity.
